

- Wallingford - Membership is down, but new members have joined. We are collecting same fees we had last year since we had just increased them recently. Programs don't need membership. Facebook and Instagram. 1 joined. Facebook public viewing, members for comments

- Liz Champeon, Eastern Maine Camera Club has some thoughts
  - *Charge or not for program nights*
  - *Local garden club - created some booklets on for \$5 that is working , what about something like this for a camera*
    - Calendars, local town brochure, fund raiser with other club (like Lions club), real estate agents handouts on your town, local theater group as audience for dress rehearsal
- Wallingford - We only did fundraising in the past through in-person activities like Taste of Wallingford (all activities like this in the area are cancelled until at least May 2021)
- Boston - On the Home Page of the website there is a “Donate” button. It’s working 😊



# What have you tried that is working?

## Comments

- Wallingford - We are using Instagram and Facebook some but only about ½ our members use social media for various reasons.
- Boston - The “10 minute Social Hour” with which we start our meetings has gotten good feedback and members seem to enjoy it. - Break out rooms for subgroups
- Boston - Opening meetings to other clubs has been a great success. Stony Brook has taken a real lead with that
- Boston - We are using Instagram to promote the club and members’ work. We are hoping to attract new members through it as well as raise awareness of the club (only running for a month, unknown impact)
