



Boston Club

- Continue with weekly ZOOM meetings - inviting the ability to have speakers with a wide variety of interests and from different locals.
 - We have been having more sharing of programs - Boston has been invited and has invited several area clubs to join us.
 - Consider joining Canadian Association of Photograph Arts (CAPA is the PSA of Canada)
 - Photographic Guild of Nova Scotia (PGNS) has invited us to several of their ZOOM meetings
- Wondering if NECCC wanted to create a virtual exhibit representing every club.
 - For example, Limit to 1 digital image per photographer –
 - A virtual show with several categories (B&W, Water, Landscapes, Portraits, Wildlife or Birds, you get the idea)
 - I would think you could get some judges to volunteer their time - and maybe different judges for each category

Highlighting a few ideas from our previous meetings

1. Leaders and Learnings – share a photo, leader edits, and other variations, some by camera brand
2. Annual competition and exhibit
3. Judges outside of the local area, outside of NECCC
4. "Field Trip" – category on local town, train tracks, water ...
5. Members bring a friend
6. Trial memberships – free for the rest of the season
7. Monthly meet a member article – collage or gallery of photos, how club has helped them
8. Using social media – push program nights in many online forums
9. Scavenger Hunt – timeline and change of pace to get camera out at home
10. Gear Groups – groups that meet independently of the rest of the club on defined photo areas
11. Help a local community group
12. Open meeting to other clubs – notify a few other clubs, post to NECCC blog
13. Posting competition photos to club Facebook, Instagram
14. Phone photography competition
15. Virtual Exhibits, on your website, library website, various living communities ...

Open Discussion
