

Do you have a candidate to nominate before March 1?

NECCC Honors Description and Criteria

ANEC

Associate Member, New England Camera Club Council

- Located outside of the New England area
- 2) Made extensive appearances at the NECCC annual conference or 20 lectures to New England camera clubs

MNEC

Master Member, New England Camera Club Council

- Performed exceptional service to the Council for several years, and
- 2) Have substantially advanced photography in the New England area through lecturing, teaching, judging and other administrative activities in their community
- 3) Maximum of 5 per year awarded

HonNEC

Honorary Member, New England Camera Club Council

- Candidate must have been awarded an MNEC to be considered for this honor
- 2) Superior leadership in the operation of our Council, such as a minimum of two years as president or five years in any other office, or
- Superior photographic leadership and recognition
- Minimum of ten years lecturing, judging, writing and administrative activities
- 5) Maximum of 2 per year awarded
